COURSE DESCRIPTION:

ACP 511 – Emergency Diagnosis & Treatment 6 credit 96 hours

This course deals with the field diagnosis and treatment of pre-hospital emergencies at the paramedic level. Diagnosis is made through a combination of physical exams, systems, patient histories, and diagnostic tests carried out in the field. Students will apply different diagnosis techniques to life threatening conditions that can be mitigated in the field. Focus will be on differentiating life-threatening conditions from conditions that should be managed in the hospital.

Upon completion of the Emergency Diagnosis & treatment course the student will be able to:

- Utilize basic life support skills and knowledge to best help patients in need.
- Utilize Advanced Life Support care to best assist the sick and injured patient in a timely fashion.
