RECEPTION TO FOLLOW IN ELEMENTS

A history OF THE CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace, originally a weapon, has over the centuries become a symbol of order and authority. The ceremonial mace adds meaning and dignity to the commencement ritual. It reminds both participants and spectators that education is one of the most cherished attributes of a free and democratic society.

Keyano College's Ceremonial Mace, carried in academic processions, is a symbol of academic authority and a part of college history. The piece was commissioned in 2010.

The mace is 48 inches tall and was lathed using cherry wood; it weighs 3.6 kilograms. The base, pedestal, and headframe were crafted by Randy Ringheim, Instructor, Welding – School of Trades and Heavy Industrial and showcases creativity within the trades. The headpiece was forged using traditional blacksmithing techniques and mild steel material.

The mace is on display during the year and is housed in a secure location in the Office of the Registrar.

The mace is carried by the Grand Marshall. The Grand Marshall for the 2022 Convocation ceremony was chosen by the Keyano College Faculty Association (KCFA). Patricia Collins, College & Career Preparation Instructor, is a long-serving faculty member with over 17 years of service at Keyano College. Each year during Convocation, Patricia has the privilege of cheering on graduates who were once her biology or chemistry students. This year she is honoured to have been selected as the Grand Marshall for Convocation 2022.



HISTORY OF THE GOVERNOR GENERAL'S COLLEGIATE BRONZE ACADEMIC MEDAL

ZEESHAN HAMAYUN

Environmental Technology Diploma

Lord Dufferin, Canada's third Governor General after Confederation, created the Academic Medals in 1873 to encourage academic excellence across the nation. Over the years, they have become the most prestigious award that students in Canadian schools can receive.

For more than 140 years, the Governor General's Academic Medals have recognized the outstanding scholastic achievements of students in Canada. They are awarded to the student graduating with the highest average from a high school, as well as from approved college or university programs. Pierre Trudeau, Tommy Douglas, Kim Campbell, Robert Bourassa, Robert Stanfield and Gabrielle Roy are just some of the more than 50 000 people who have received the Governor General's Academic Medal as the start of a life of accomplishment.

Today, the Governor General's Academic Medals are awarded at four distinct levels: Bronze at the secondary school level; Collegiate Bronze at the post-secondary, diploma level; Silver at the undergraduate level; and Gold at the graduate level. Medals are presented on behalf of the Governor General by participating educational institutions, along with personalized certificates signed by the Governor General.

To maintain a spirit of universality across the country, the Directives were designed to ensure that the medals are awarded on academic marks only, regardless of the more intangible qualities of students' life, such as good citizenship, moral behaviour or popularity.

The COLLEGIATE BRONZE medal is awarded to the student who achieves the highest overall average upon graduation from a diploma-level, post-secondary program (minimum two-year, full-time duration).


It is my hope that your education will be the stepping stone to a rewarding life.




