A history OF THE CEREMONIAL MACE

The ceremonial mace, originally a weapon, has over the centuries become a symbol of order and authority. The ceremonial mace adds meaning and dignity to the commencement ritual. It reminds both participants and spectators that education is one of the most cherished attributes of a free and democratic society.

Keyano College's Ceremonial Mace, carried in academic processions, is a symbol of academic authority and a part of college history. The piece was commissioned in 2010.

The mace is 48 inches tall and was lathed using cherry wood; it weighs 3.6 kilograms. The base, pedestal, and headframe were crafted by Randy Ringheim, Instructor, Welding – School of Trades and Heavy Industrial and showcases creativity within the trades. The headpiece was forged using traditional blacksmithing techniques and mild steel material.

The mace is on display during the year and is housed in a secure location in the Office of the Registrar.






HISTORY OF THE GOVERNOR GENERAL'S ACADEMIC MEDAL


