Minimum passing grade of D is required for all courses, please note, those indicated with an “*” are pre-requisite courses for future course in the program and require a minimum grade of “C-”. Students that are looking to move into the diploma later on, the minimum passing grade is a C- for all certificate courses as they are pre-requisites for the diploma.

Graduation
