#### **Transferability**

For information on transfer to various post-secondary institutions, please refer to the Alberta Transfer Guide at <a href="mailto:transferalberta.alberta.ca">transferalberta.alberta.ca</a>. Please note that every institution has its own policy regarding minimum grades needed for transfer credit.

#### **Progression Policy**

- A minimum of C+ is required to pass all foundational nursing courses (NURS 106, NURS 116, NURS 120, NURS 124, NURS 124, MMI 133)
- A minimum of a C- is required to pass all other nursing and non-nursing courses.
- For yearly promotion, a student must have successfully completed all courses from the previous year and obtain a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- Student with a semester GPA 1.7-1.99 will be placed on academic probation for one term.
- A student with a GPA of 1.69 or lower must withdraw from the program.
- Student on academic probation, who fail to achieve a cumulative GPA of 2.0 by the end of the next term will be required to withdraw from the program.
- If the GPA warrants a second academic probation within the program, the student will be required to withdraw from the program and will not be readmitted into the program.
- Readmission to the program is subject to departmental review by the Chair and Dean of the program and alignment with College Policies.
- Students who fail a second clinical course or a clinical course for the for the second time will be required to withdraw from the program and will not be readmitted.

In Year 3, BScN students must apply for official admission into the University of Alberta for Year 4.
