**NOTE 1:** If you take Canadian History 260 or 261 in Year 1, then you will need 3\* of social science in either fall or winter of year 2.

**NOTE 2:** students may only have 3\* of Statistics for the Math Element (you **cannot** use STAT 151 & SOCY 210 to meet the Math Element as they are both Statistics)

**Minimum passing grade of D is required for all courses, please note, those indicated with an “ \* ” are possible pre-requisite courses for future course in the program and require a minimum grade of “C-” .**

### Transferability

**\*A minimum grade of C- is required to transfer to the University of Alberta.**



All 60 credits listed below must be completed by the end of April of the year in which you plan to be in Year 3. Intakes into year 3 take place every second year in odd-numbered years. The next intake into year 3 is Fall 2025, and the next year after that will be Fall 2027.
