Transferability

For information on transfer to various post-secondary institutions, please refer to the Alberta Transfer Guide at transferalberta.ca. Please note that every institution has its own policy regarding minimum grades needed for transfer credit. Students transferring to the University of Alberta must achieve a minimum grade of C- in each course and an overall GPA of 2.0 in order to obtain course credit from the university.

Students who complete the Art & Design program may be eligible to transfer into year two of a Bachelor of Fine Arts or Bachelor of Design degree at the Alberta University of the Arts (minimum grade of C is required for transfer). For those choosing to study at another school, please refer to the Alberta Transfer Guide or speak with your Art instructor.

Graduation

Students with a passing grade in each course, who successfully complete the program of study and obtained an overall Grade Point Average of 1.7 or better shall be issued a certificate. **Grades of D may impact your eligibility to graduate.**
